### Dam Update:



- Work started this week (12/8) and should take 2 3 weeks
- Cost = \$62,750.00 (would have seen a 3% increase in 2021 based on material costs)
  - \$25,000 down payment already made
  - \$25,000 due at the completion of the project
  - Remaining \$12,750 to be paid once 2021 dues have been collected (at 7% APR)
- Details:
  - 545 linear feet of Dam
  - 6-7' from dam
  - Install on a 1 to 1 slope using 12-18" shot rock

# During construction, Dam is an active jobsite – for your safety, please stay away until job is completed

## Financial Update:

- Bank balance November 30<sup>th</sup> = \$27,739
- 2020 general expenditures through end of November = \$8,300
- 2020 cost cutting moves
  - Lawn cutting the common area has been split amongst board members.
     We do have lawn service for the north side of the lake. Approx. savings of \$1,200 a year.
  - Moved the website to a new host saving approx. \$100 a year
  - Decreased the QuickBooks software to a basic version which saves approx.
     \$160 a year
- 2021 dues update Due reminders were sent out, and we are starting to see payments coming in.
